
FAST FACTS FROM THE 2016 GHANA MIS

Malaria Prevalence by Region


Percent of children age 6-59 months who tested positive for malaria by microscopy



21% of children age 6-59 months tested positive for malaria by microscopy.

> Malaria prevalence ranges from a low of 5% in Greater Accra to a high of 31% in Eastern.

MALARIA PREVENTION



52% of children under 5 and 50% of pregnant women slept under an LLIN the night before the survey.



60% of pregnant women received 3+ doses of SP/Fansidar to prevent malaria in pregnancy.
