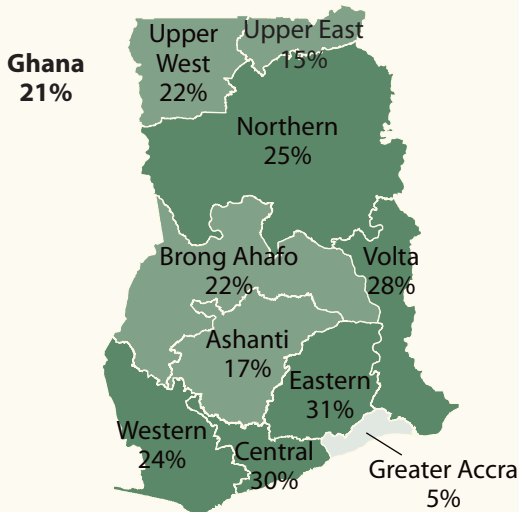
## FAST FACTS FROM THE 2016 GHANA MIS

The 2016 Ghana Malaria Indicator Survey (GMIS) provides population-based estimates on malaria indicators to inform strategic planning and programme evaluation. The 2016 GMIS is the 1<sup>st</sup> Malaria Indicator Survey conducted in Ghana.

### MALARIA PREVALENCE

#### Malaria Prevalence by Region

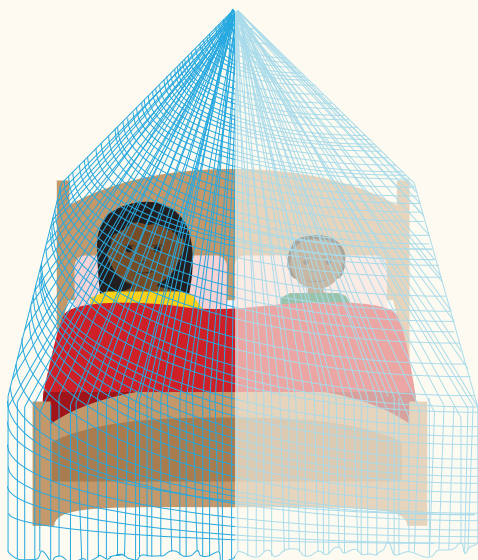
Percent of children age 6-59 months who tested positive for malaria by microscopy



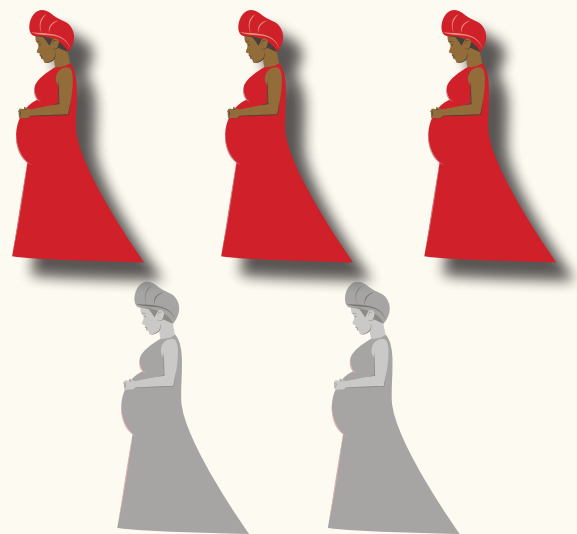
**21%** of children age 6-59 months tested positive for malaria by microscopy.

Malaria prevalence ranges from a low of 5% in Greater Accra to a high of 31% in Eastern.

### MALARIA PREVENTION



**52%** of children under 5 and **50%** of pregnant women slept under an LLIN the night before the survey.



**60%** of pregnant women received 3+ doses of SP/Fansidar to prevent malaria in pregnancy.
