2 in 3 women age 15-49 receive antenatal care from a skilled provider.


2 in 5 births are delivered in a health facility.

Trends in Childhood Mortality

Deaths per 1,000 live births for the five-year period before the survey





1 in 8 Nigerian children does not survive until their 5th birthday.

Childhood mortality has declined since 1990.

MALARIA

1 in 2 children under 5 slept under an insecticide-treated net the night before the survey.
