


FAST FACTS FROM THE 2018-19 UGANDA MALARIA INDICATOR SURVEY

The 2018-19 Uganda Malaria Indicator Survey (UMIS) provides population-based estimates on malaria indicators to inform strategic planning and programme evaluation. The 2018-19 UMIS is the 3rd Malaria Indicator Survey conducted in Uganda since 2009.

MALARIA PREVALENCE

Malaria Prevalence by Region


Percent of children under five who tested positive for malaria by microscopy




9% of Ugandan children age 0-59 months tested positive for malaria by microscopy.

Malaria prevalence ranges from <1% in Kampala and Kigezi to 34% in Karamoja.

MALARIA PREVENTION



60% of children under 5 & 65% of pregnant women slept under an insecticide-treated net (ITN) the night before the survey.



2 in 5 pregnant women received 3+ doses of SP/Fansidar to prevent malaria in pregnancy.

MALARIA MESSAGING

78% of women know that mosquitoes and mosquito bites cause malaria.
