Fertility


Women in Nigeria have an average of 5.5 children. TFR in Western African countries ranges from 4.0 in Ghana to 7.6 in Niger.

Births per woman for the 3 years prior to the survey




Family Planning

Percent of currently married women age 15-49 who are currently using any method of contraception



Trends in Vaccination CoveragePercent of children age 12-23 months vaccinated2003 NDHS2008 NDHS2003 NDHS2013 NDHS




Child Mortality
