Olyset nets should have been classified as long-lasting ITNs (this affected classification of 2,404 Olyset nets). The re-classification affects estimates of household ownership of ever-treated nets and ITNS, and use of ever-treated nets and ITNs by children and women. The nets have been correctly classified as long-lasting ITNs, and all affected text, tables, and figures have been corrected. Corrections were made to the statistics on household ownership of ever-treated nets and ITNs, use of ever-treated nets by children and women, and use of ITNs by children and women in the Summary of Findings (page xxiii), MDG table (Indicators 22 and 22A), Chapter 12 Malaria Tables 12.1, 12.2, 12.3.1, 12.3.2, Chapter 12 Malaria Figures 12.1 and 12.2, and accompanying text.
