

The 2008-09 Albania Demographic and Health Survey (ADHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in Albania. The ADHS is the first national demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The survey is based on a nationally representative sample. It provides estimates for urban and rural areas of the country and for each of the four regions.







Percentage of currently married women currently using a modern method of family planning




## **Current Use of Family Planning**




## Maternal Health Care by Region

Percentage of women who had a live birth in the five years preceding the survey




## **Immunization Coverage**

Percent of children age 18-29 months who received all recommended vaccines




## **Nutritional Status of Children**

Percent of children under age 5 whose mothers were interviewed




# Anemia Percent with any
