#### **Maternal Mortality Ratio by Zone**


Maternal-related deaths per 100,000 live births for the seven-year period before the survey


#### **All-cause Mortality**


## 2017 Ghana Maternal Health Survey (GMHS)



Percent distribution of women age 15-49 by highest level of education attended




#### **Trends in Total Fertility Rate**

#### **Trends in Family Planning Use**


Percent of married women age 15-49 using family planning

Percent of women age 15-49 who had a live birth/stillbirth in the 5 years before the survey (for most recent live birth/stillbirth)



#### **Trends in Delivery Care**


Percent of most recent live births or stillbirths in the five years before the survey
