



HIV Testing Percent of women and men age 15-49 Women Men


2016-18 Papua New Guinea Demographic and Health Survey (PNG DHS)


Water, Sanitation, and Electricity by Residence


Percent of households with: Total Urban Rural



Total Fertility Rate by Residence


Births per woman for the three-year period before the survey





Antenatal Care (ANC)


Percent of women age 15-49 with a live birth in the five years before the survey who:



*Skilled provider includes doctor, midwife, nurse (including trained community health workers), and trained village health volunteer.


Health Facility Delivery by Residence

Percent of births in the five years before the survey delivered in a health facility




Childhood Mortality
