

HIV/AIDS: Results from the 2012 KgDHS


The 2012 Kyrgyz Republic Demographic and Health Survey (KgDHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in the Kyrgyz Republic. The 2012 KgDHS is the second national demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The 2012 KgDHS included questions on HIV/AIDS-related knowledge, attitudes, and behaviors.

Overall, more than 90% of women and men have heard of AIDS.


Knowledge of HIV/AIDS by Education

Percent of women and men 15-49 who have heard of AIDS




Knowledge of HIV Prevention

Percent of women and men 15-49 who know that the risk of transmitting HIV can be reduced by:




Knowledge about AIDS Transmission

Percent of women and men 15-49 who know that:




Mother-to-Child Transmission

Percent of women and men 15-49 who know that:




Attitudes Toward People Living with HIV/AIDS

10% of men age 15-49 have had 2+ sexual partners in the past year.


41% of men have ever *paid for* sexual intercourse.
