


Fertility, Family Planning, and Abortion: Results from the 2012 TjDHS

The 2012 Tajikistan Demographic and Health Survey (TjDHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in Tajikistan. The 2012 TjDHS is the first national demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The 2012 TjDHS included questions on fertility, fertility preferences, use of family planning, and experience with abortion.

Tajik women have an average of 3.8 births.




Fertility in Central and Southern Asia






Median age in years among women age 25-49

More than I in 5 Tajik women have an *unmet need for family planning* that is, they want no more children or want to wait at least 2 years before another child but are not using contraception.

Modern Method Use by Education


Percent of married women 15–49 using a modern method

Percent of married women 15–49 with an unmet need for family planning






10% of Tajik women have ever had an *abortion*.


