


Tajik Households: Results from the 2012 TjDHS

The 2012 Tajikistan Demographic and Health Survey (TjDHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in Tajikistan. The 2012 TjDHS is the first national demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The household questionnaire in the TjDHS captures information on drinking water, sanitation, household possessions, household membership, and educational levels.



Trends in Use of Improved Drinking Water


Percent of population with an improved source of drinking water 2000 MICS 2005 MICS 2012 TjDHS








Sanitation Facilities

38% of household members are under age 15.


Household Characteristics and Possessions

Percent of households with selected items




Trends in Ownership of Household Goods

Percent of households with household items 2005 MICS 2012 TjDHS








Education of Household Members
