


Fertility, Family Planning, and Abortion: Results from the 2012 KgDHS

The 2012 Kyrgyz Republic Demographic and Health Survey (KgDHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in the Kyrgyz Republic. The 2012 KgDHS is the second national demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The 2012 KgDHS included questions on fertility, fertility preferences, use of family planning, and experience with abortion.

Women have an average of 3.6 births.

Fertility Trends by Residence




Age at First Marriage, Sex, and Birth


Median age in years among women and men age 25-49







Current use of Contraception



Kyrgyz Republic - 34%




Unmet Need by Education

that is, they want no more children or want to wait at least 2 years before another child but are not using contraception.






















18% of women have ever had an **abortion**.


Number of Abortions

Among women who have had an abortion, percent distribution by number of abortions




Lifetime Experience with Abortion by Number of Children
