


Maternal and Child Health: Results from the 2012 KgDHS

The 2012 Kyrgyz Republic Demographic and Health Survey (KqDHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in the Kyrgyz Republic. The 2012 KgDHS is the second national demographic and health survey conducted in the country.

The 2012 KgDHS included guestions on antenatal care, delivery care, and postnatal care, as well as guestions on childhood vaccinations, illnesses, and mortality.

Trends in Maternal Health Care




84% of pregnant women received

the recommended 4+ antenatal care visits


79% of women attended their first ANC visit during their 1st trimester of pregnancy, as recommended.


Timing of Postnatal Care

Mother Infant Percent of women who gave birth in the 2 years before the survey, percent of last births in the 2 years before the survey




Vaccination Coverage by Wealth Quintile

Percent of children 18-29 months who have received all basic vaccinations








Under-5 Mortality by Birth Interval


Number of under-5 deaths per 1,000 live births for the 10 year period before the survey
