


Percentage of ever-married women age 15-49 who have ever experienced emotional, physical, or sexual violence committed by their current or most recent husband/partner



Percentage of household population with an improved sanitation facility




Educational Attainment in Banjul

Percent distribution of women age 15-49 by highest level of schooling attended or completed




Fertility by LGA

Total fertility rate for the 3 years before the survey




Modern Contraceptive Use in Banjul

Percentage of married women age 15-49 using family planning





Childhood Mortality in Banjul


Deaths per 1,000 live births in the 10-year period before the survey
