

Anaemia in Children and Women by LGA




Spousal Violence in Janjanbureh



The 2019-20 GDHS is the 2nd Demographic and Health Survey conducted in the country. The survey is based on a nationally representative sample. It provides estimates at the national and LGA levels, as well as for urban and rural areas.





Percent distribution of women age 15-49 by highest level of schooling attended or completed




Modern Contraceptive Use in Janjanbureh


Percentage of married women age 15-49 using family planning
